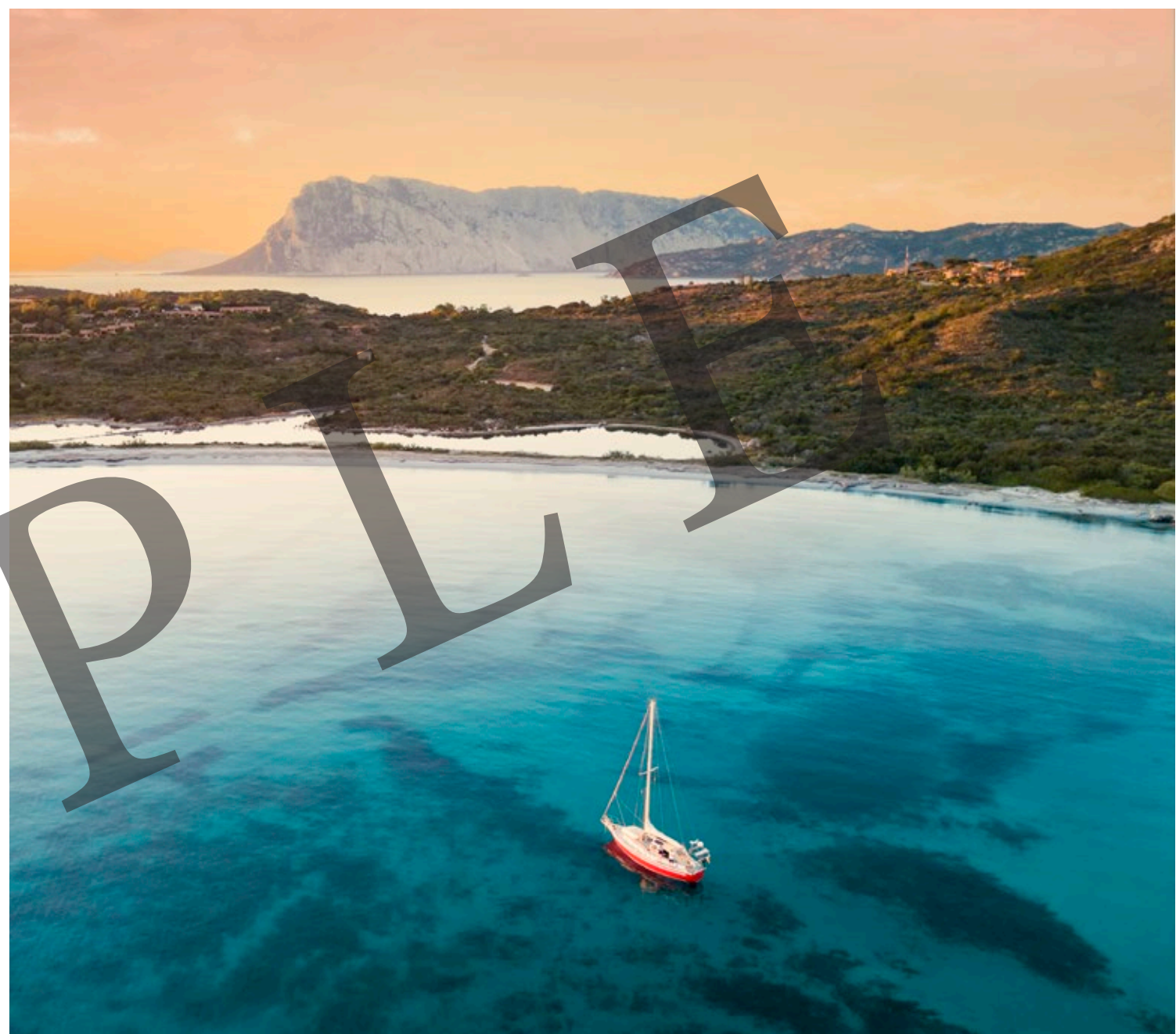

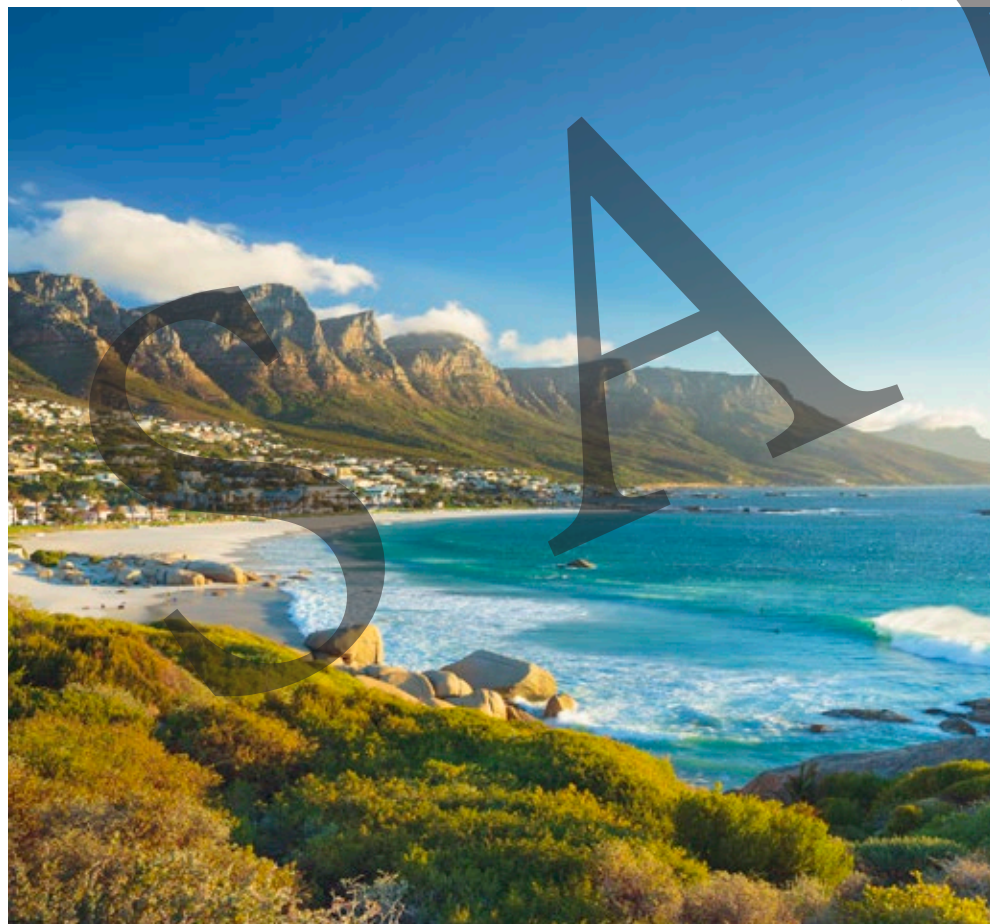

Taichung, Taiwan

Once a purely industrial city, Taichung is quickly catching on among travelers looking to get off the beaten path. A melting pot of cultural and culinary delights, it's easy to see why this Taiwanese city is a trending destination for 2022. Don't miss a stroll through Rainbow Village, once slated for demolition, a neighborhood for former members of the military, to see to see the colorful murals that cover nearly every surface. One of the things Taiwan is most famous for is its night markets, and Taichung has plenty of them. Head to Feng-Chia Night Market to explore the numerous food stalls and refuel after a long day of exploring.

South Africa

South Africa is famous for many things—diverse wildlife, award-winning wineries, beautiful beaches and cosmopolitan cities. It can be difficult to know where to begin when you could easily spend months exploring and barely scratch the surface. Kruger National Park is one of the best places to see the “Big Five” (lions, leopards, elephants, rhinoceroses, and Cape buffalo), while Cape Town offers visitors excellent beaches (like Boulders and Clifton) and stunning views from Table Mountain.

The Dolomites, Italy

Located in northeastern Italy, the Dolomites are a playground for both outdoor enthusiasts and culture vultures. A part of Austria until after WWI, this ruggedly beautiful mountain range reflects traces of that history in the cuisine and language. Expect to eat lots of speck and see road signs in two or three languages. It's easy to dive deep into this region's war-torn history at the Bunker Museum and Forte Tre Sassi. Both museums highlight the hardships soldiers faced during WWI. Unsurprisingly, hiking is a big deal here. One of the most spectacular routes is the six-mile circumnavigation of Tre Cime di Lavardo. The trails take visitors past meadows of wildflowers and small lakes.



Antarctica

Antarctica truly is one of Earth's last frontiers, so there's no surprise it's on the travel bucket lists of outdoor enthusiasts and adventure lovers. Despite the lack of, well, civilization, there's plenty to do. Camp under the stars, hang out with the penguins, visit a science research station, go whale watching and even swim in the caldera of an active volcano.

One of the best ways to experience this continent is on an expedition-style cruise. Companies like Linblad and Ponant offer some of the most comprehensive experiences for those looking to fit a lot of activities into a short amount of time!

Nagano, Japan

Situated northwest of Tokyo, Nagano is an incredibly beautiful and historic part of Japan that's recently skyrocketed to the top of many travelers' must-visit lists. Once the host city for the 1998 Winter Olympics, what's really special about Nagano is the marks different religions have left on the city's architecture. The Zenko-Ji Temple houses Japan's first Buddhist statue. Also not to miss is the iconic 16th-century Matsumoto Castle, with its striking black facade and picturesque grounds filled with cherry orchards. Another must - sampling pan-fried Oyaki, traditional dumplings made from soba flour and filled with red bean paste or squash. If you're feeling extra adventurous, hike up to Togakushi Shrine. The hike up to all five shrines lasts around two hours and takes visitors past waterfalls, ponds and local fauna.

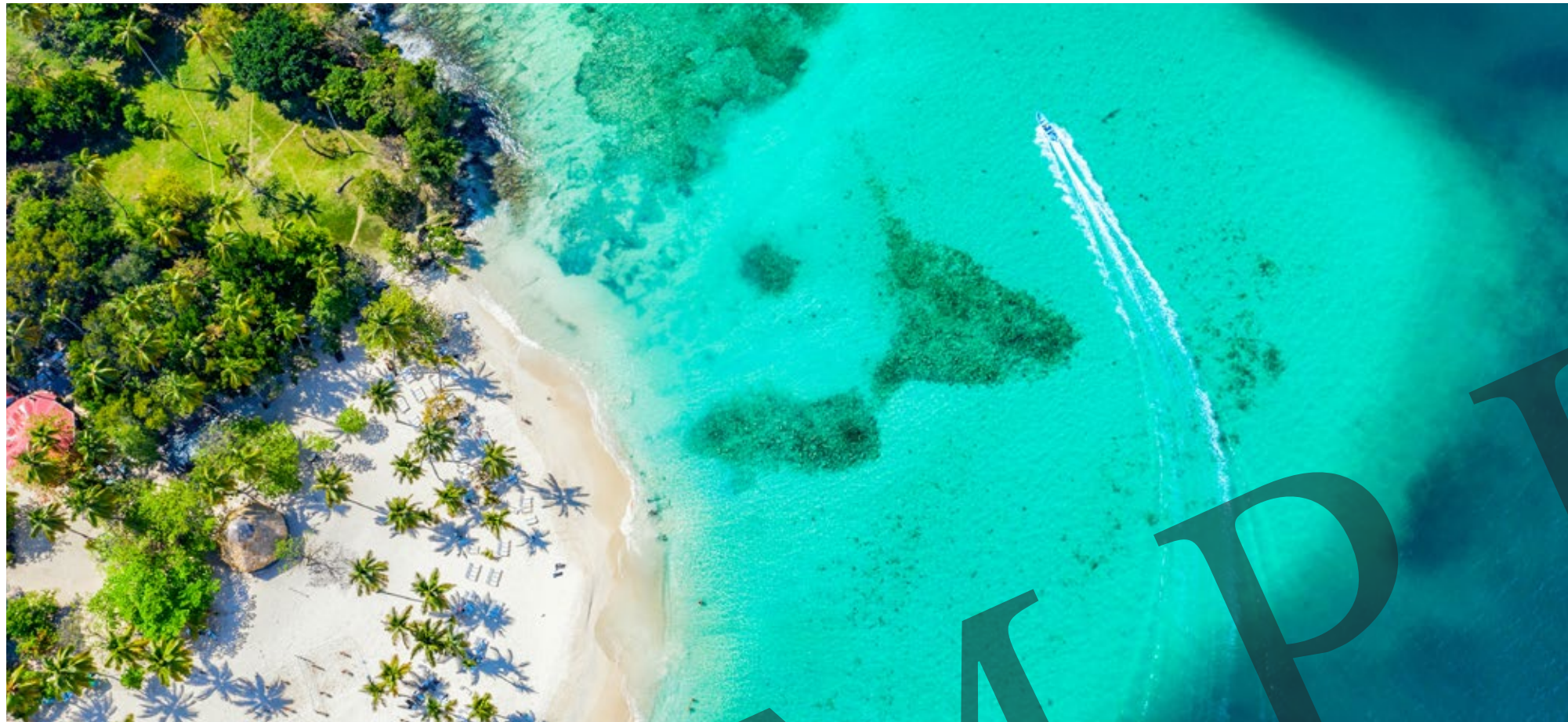

Sardinia, Italy

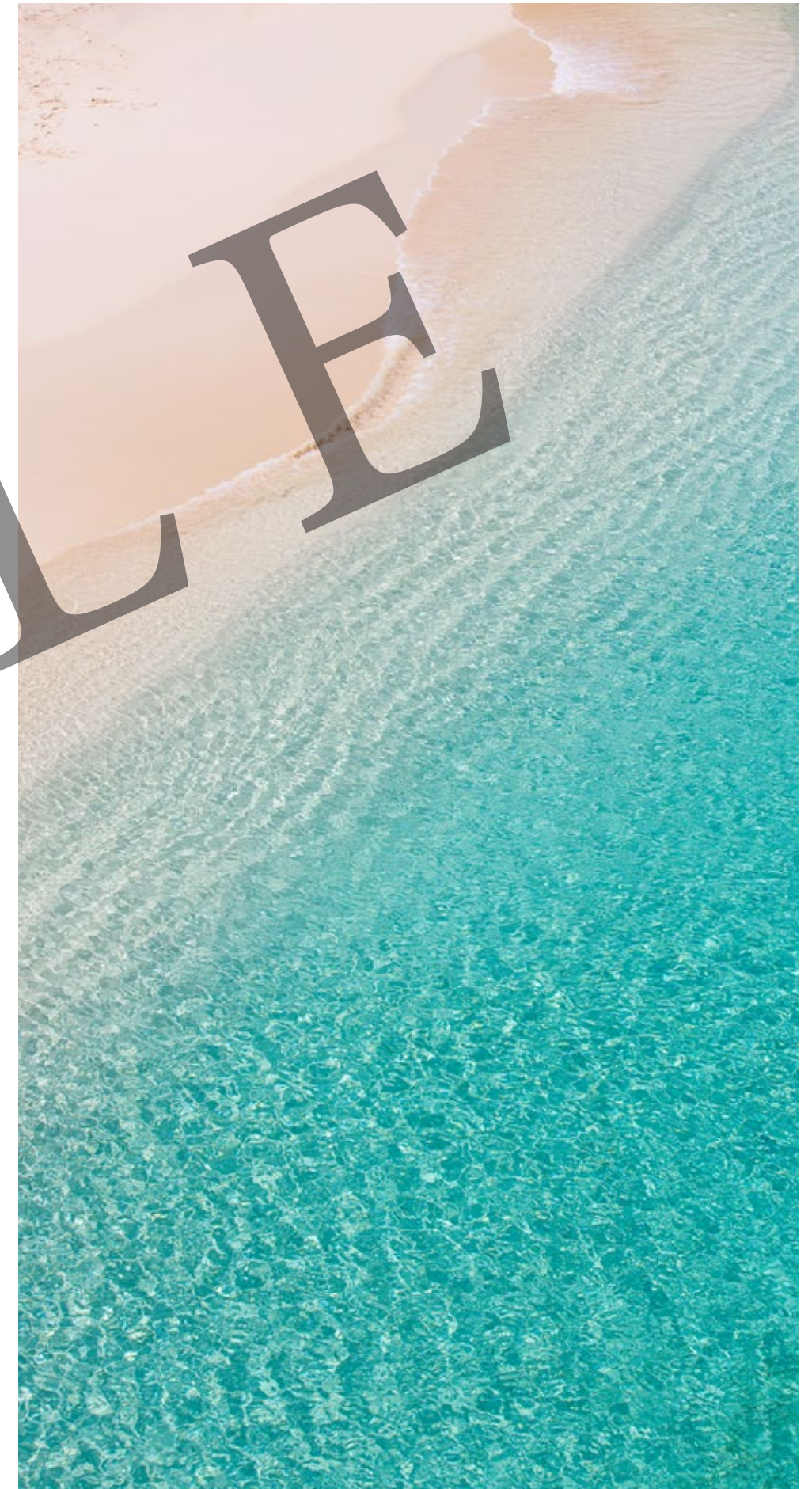

Los Angeles, California

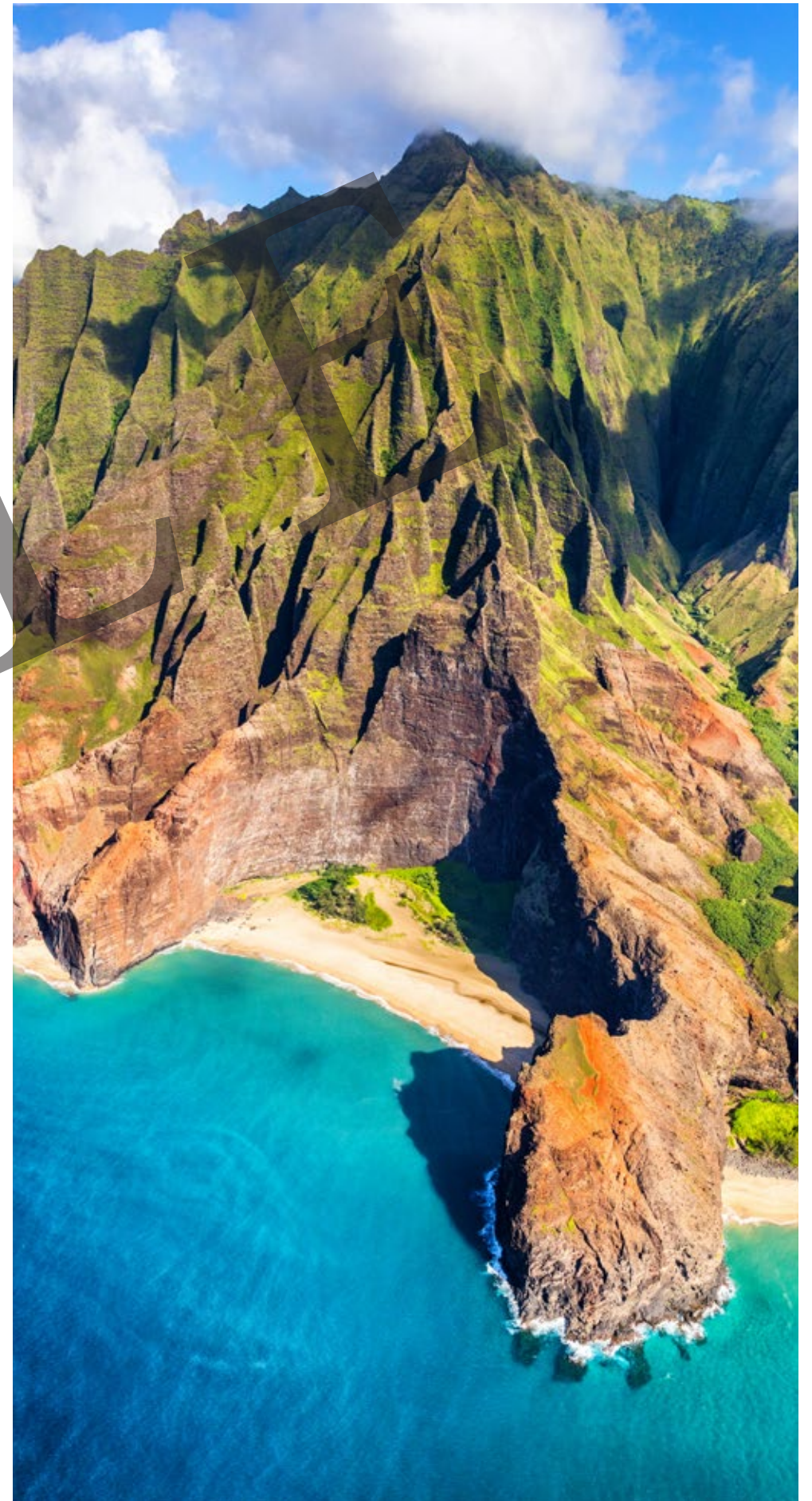

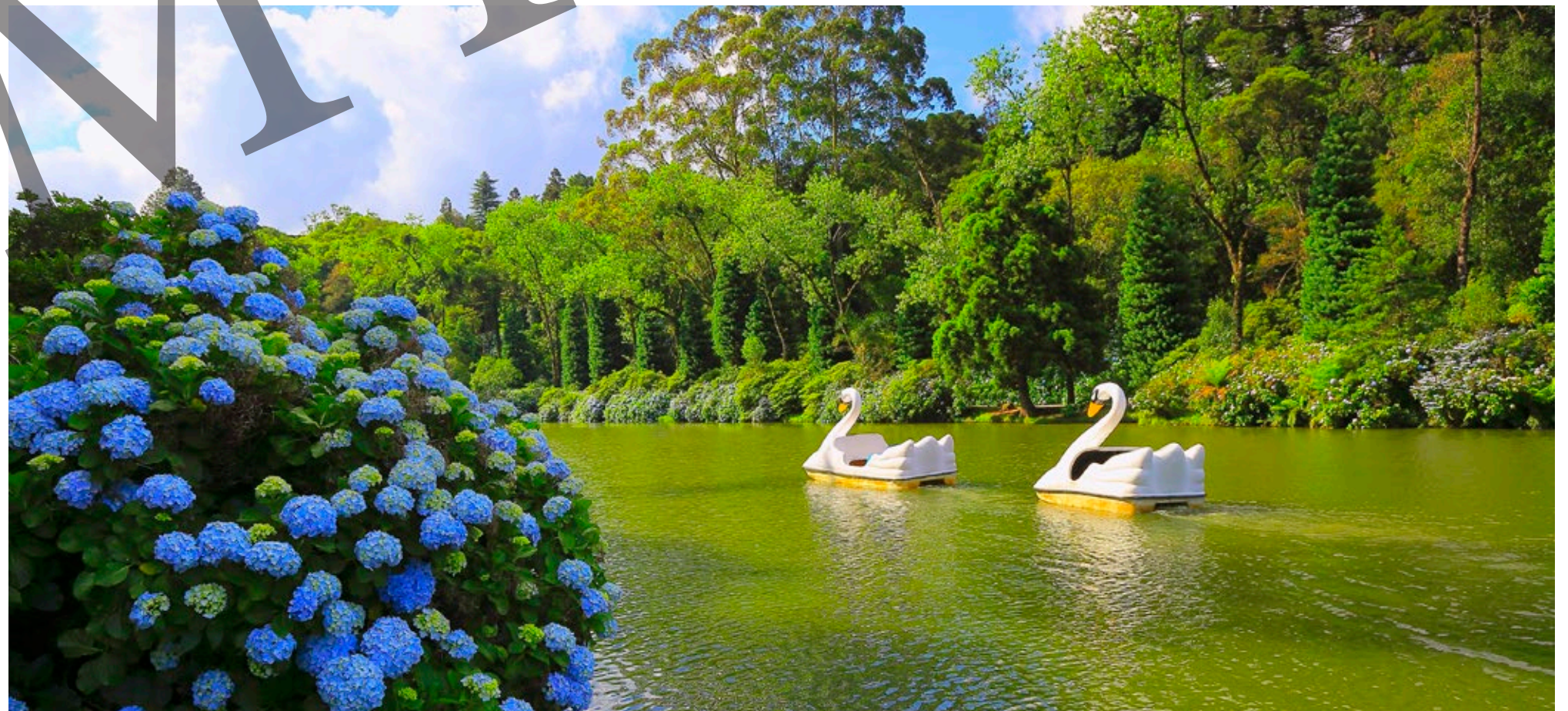

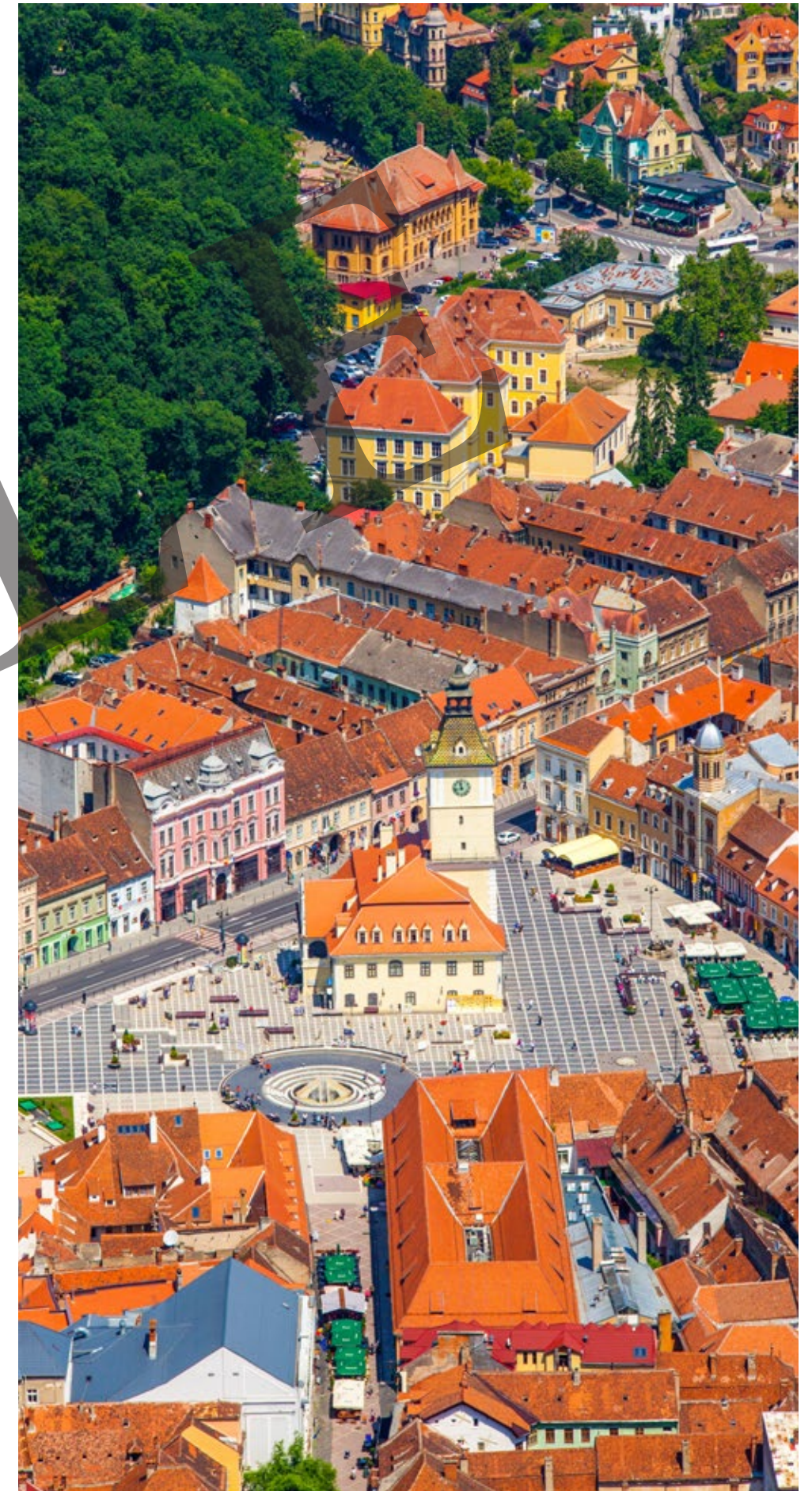


Brasov, Romania

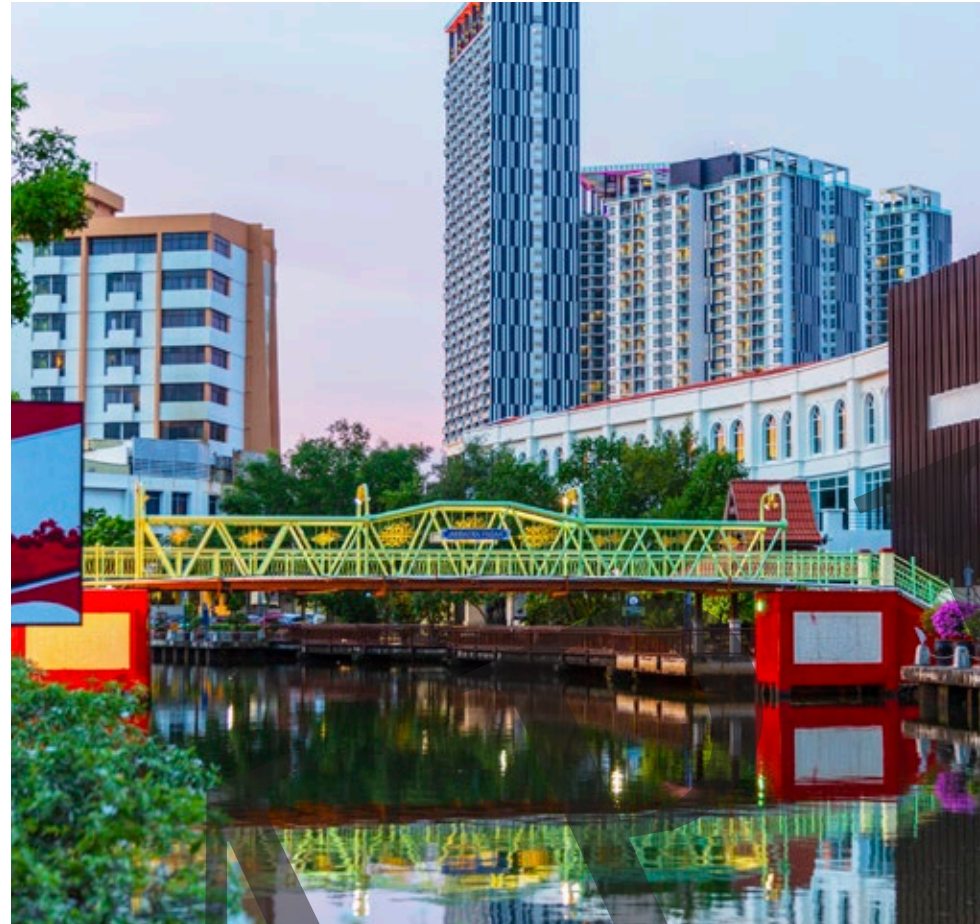

Malacca, Malaysia

Some highlights of Malacca include Cheng Hoon Chinese Temple—dating from the 17th century, it's the oldest temple of its kind in the country—enjoying city views from the Taming Sari Revolving Tower, and sampling street food at Jonker Walk Night Market.
